



Exhibition

The ICT/ECT 2012 conference will set a new standard in involvement of conference delegates and surroundings. All breaks will be taken in the Boiler Hall (*Kedelhallen*), a publicly accessible part of Nordkraft. Here, also the exhibition will be located. Rather than separating delegates from ordinary visitors or tourists, this will enhance the visibility of the conference to the general public and provide a significant exposure platform for both exhibitors and sponsors.

Stands rental:

The stands will be put up in the Boiler Hall. As the Boiler Hall is a publicly part of Nordkraft there will be a limited number of stands. Therefore, the reservations will be done according to the principle: "first come first served".
The stand size is 6 square meters and the price is € 1,350.

What is in the price included:

- Stand with one back and one side wall
- Stand lighting, rack mounted with 3 spotlights
- 1 round table (60 cm diameter/ 110 cm height) or 1 information counter (100 cm x 50 cm x 110 cm)
(please let us know what you prefer when you book a stand)
- 2 bar stools
- 220 V single-phase sockets
- Wireless internet
- 2 conference admission tickets including lunches and coffee for the whole period
- 2 x free admission to "The Mayors Welcome Reception" and "The Poster Session"

How about insurance:

The exhibitor is required to take out an insurance policy against personal injury and stolen goods. Conference staff will be at the exhibition site during the hours where the conference venue is not closed up.

How to book a stand:

Please note that if you as an exhibitor are interested in participating in the banquet, a banquet dinner ticket may be bought for € 90. The banquet dinner ticket covers food, beverages and transportation and should be booked together with the stand. We will send you a confirmation followed by an invoice once having received your email.
