  - Charts, table, graphics and pictures cannot be inserted into the abstract, special characters, however, may be included.
  - There is a 300-word maximum for abstracts.
  - Please format your abstract only in a standard font as ?Arial? or ?Times New Roman?; the formatting for use of your abstract within the abstract book will be done automatically after submission by the system.
  - More details on the use of the abstract submission system is provided directly during the submission process.
- Please note that you will receive one e-mail notification when your abstract has been submitted and is pending review, and another notification when its status has been determined (accepted/rejected).
